I am the President of COVITE - Collective of Victims of Terrorism -, the Spanish non-governmental organization that last February submitted a communication to the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court (Ref: **OTP-CR-61/14**) demanding that the crimes of the terrorist organization ETA are declared “crimes against humanity” (Art. 7 Rome Statute).

Please find enclosed a further report we would like the Prosecutor to have access to, in which we explain more in detail ETA’s crimes, especially those after 2002. In the document several charts can be found, which only include data extrictly backed by definitive judicial judgements. At the end of the document we have added an externes Excel table that provides a chronological list of all the terrorists attacks performed by ETA since 2002.

We hope this information helps the prosecutor to have a better and more clear idea about the core elements of our claim.
